

BRS Saves #109-110



Flying in their Silent Racer trike with retractable gear, a German pilot and his female passenger entered a steepening spiral. Unable to regain control with the ground quickly approaching, the pilot deployed his BRS-900. Landing areas were few, but the parachute allowed the trike to settle into a small area only twice the size of the trike itself. The pilot lowered the gear before touchdown and was rewarded with little damage.

After impact, I discovered only the gear had slight damage and I was uninjured. My passenger suffered only a small cut on the lip when she hit the back of my helmet. All was well!”
